What is the Certificate and Subsidiary Diploma?

A Subsidiary Diploma is a practical, work-related course which is equivalent to one AS/A level and is a one- or two-year course. The one-year course is called the Certificate in Hospitality and the two-year course is called the Subsidiary Diploma in Hospitality.

This course has been developed in the hospitality industry to give you the opportunity to enter employment in the hospitality industry or continue to higher education. These qualifications also give you the opportunity to develop a range of skills, techniques, personal skills, and attributes essential for successful performance in working life.

Course content

In the 1st year, the Certificate in Hospitality consists of a core unit:

- The Hospitality Industry

Plus 2 specialist units such as:

- Food and Drinks Service
- Planning and Managing a Hospitality Event
- Food Service Organisation

In the 2nd year, the Subsidiary Diploma in Hospitality consists of the following core units:

- Principles of Supervising Customer Service Performance in Hospitality, Leisure, Travel and Tourism
- Providing Customer Service in Hospitality
- Plus 2 specialist units such as
- Food service organisation
- Events organisation
- Environment and Sustainability in Hospitality

How is the course assessed?

There are no exams for this qualification; You will be assessed on coursework.
